Dear Parishioners and Friends of our Parish:

Our telephone/communication system broke down last week and has been replaced at a cost of \$4,000.00. This was the lowest bid and the work has been accomplished by a former Parishioner with expertise in the field. We are so grateful to a Parish family, who, when they heard this, came forward with a donation to cover the cost. Our deepest thanks and prayers for God's special blessings on them and their family.

These past weeks we have sought to be reminded that we are all called to be Stewards of God's gifts. Your response has been inspiring. When we made an appeal for more Lectors to proclaim God's Word, 16 people came forward! Simply amazing. Thank you for your generous spirit of serving.

In the weeks ahead, we are expecting to begin completion of the 2nd floor of the east wing which will provide needed meeting rooms for Religious Ed and other parish groups. The estimated cost of this is \$195,000.00 which we have in reserve as a result of the 2010 Capital Campaign and funds received in the Building Fund. Rather than make a special appeal for this purpose, I invite you to consider responding by an added gift to the Parish Collection or the Building Fund. In this manner, we will be able to replenish the reserve which we will be using. Thank you so much for your consideration and may the Lord reward your loving return in faith to the good works of the Church.
